Sam Gibbons Memorial Horse Show at the Sheriff's Arena on Alabama 99 to benefit the museum.

“Mr. Sam,” as Gibbons was known, loved Tennessee walking horses. He was the ringmaster for the World Champion Tennessee Walking Horse Show in Shelbyville for 37 years.

Gibbons bred, raised and showed world champion colts. There is a street named for Gibbons in Shelbyville to honor his dedication and service to the horse industry.

He also is in the Walking Horse Hall of Fame.

Gibbon's other love was the Veterans Museum. He volunteered at the museum from its beginning in 2002, was on the executive board of directors and served as the museum treasurer until 2009. He died March 22, 2010.

The museum staff felt this event would be an excellent way to pay tribute to Gibbons, bring to Athens a family friendly activity and help to maintain the museum.

The show will feature 32 classes with a lead line and stick horse class, up to the stake class of the professional trainers for aged stallions and geldings.

The Walking Horse Trainers' Association (WHTA) has extended the deadline for licensed members to sign up for the 2012 Riders' Cup. The new deadline will be Friday May 25, 2012, which is the second day of the Spring Fun Show in Shelbyville, Tenn.

CELEBRATING CHANGES: NEW BOXES IN SOUTH TURN

The Tennessee Walking Horse National Celebration is renovating the upper tier of boxes on the south end of the outdoor arena, in a \$500,000 project which CEO Doyle Meadows says will enhance safety and the fan experience.

The lower level of boxes, at ringside, are built on concrete slabs and are in good shape, as are the general admission grandstands at the top of the south end. The renovation project focuses on the upper rows of boxes -- I, J, K and L -- on the south end.

MASSIVE UPGRADE

The concrete beneath those boxes, including some long-closed restrooms, is being demolished to expose the steel superstructure beneath. The steel will be sandblasted and repainted. New concrete will be poured, and new railings will be put up between the boxes. A new staircase will be built at the southwest corner, allowing improved access to the area.

“Although the actual structure was sound,” said Meadows, “we wanted to make sure the safety of our fans was of the utmost importance.”

Meadows said the Celebration was pleased to hire a local firm, Lee Adcock Construction, to do the work, which began earlier this month and which is expected to be complete by late July, in plenty of time for this year's Celebration.

CONCESSION CHANGES

The work will affect the two concession stands located beneath those boxes at the southwest corner of the arena: Shelbyville Rotary Club's pizza booth and the Shelbyville Central High School Band Boosters. Meadows said both of those organizations were “wonderfully receptive,” even though it's involved cost and trouble for them. He said both will end up with improved facilities as a result of the work.

Meadows noted that this has been a time of challenge for the industry which the Celebration represents, but he said the organization felt it was important to go forward with the project.
