BEYOND THE BREEDING BARN

WGC HONORS



Some horses win major titles. Some horses become legends. Honors did both, and then kept going.

Standing at Carl Edwards and Sons Stables in Dawson, Georgia, Honors has become one of the most influential breeding stallions in the Tennessee Walking Horse industry, but long before his name began stacking up in sire records and championship pedigrees, he made his name the old fashioned way in the show ring. Sired by The Titleist and out of Pushover's Mark, the striking black stallion was bred by Brian Anderton of Moulton, Alabama. From the start, he had the kind of presence that made people stop and watch.

HONORS

Honors began his show ring career in 2010 with Justin Harris, winning the Al Miller Memorial Two Year Old Stallions Championship. It was an early sign of what was to come. After that blue, he was purchased by Keith McSwain. During the remainder of his two year old season, Honors added the Columbia Spring Jubilee Amateur Two Year Old Stallions Championship and the FAST Showcase Amateur Two Year Old Stallions Championship. In the spring of his three year old year, he left the amateur ranks and stepped into the open division with Larry Edwards in the irons, and with a new division came a new chapter under the direction of Larry and Gary Edwards at Carl Edwards and Sons Stables.

In 2011, Honors won the Red Carpet Show of the South Three Year Old Stallions Championship, then headed to Shelbyville and captured both the Three Year Old Stallions World Championship and the Three Year Old World Grand Championship at the Tennessee Walking Horse National Celebration.



He came right back in 2012 and kept the pressure on, winning the Money Tree Classic Four Year Old Championship, the Four Year Old Stallions World Championship, the Four Year Old World Grand Championship, and the North Carolina Championship Grand Championship.

By then, he was no longer just a talented young horse. He was becoming one of the industry's headline horses. In 2013, he added the Gulf Coast Charity Grand Championship, the Spring Fun Show Grand Championship, and the Southern Championship Charity Grand Championship. In 2014, he won the Red Carpet Show of the South Grand Championship. In 2015, he returned to claim the Spring Fun Show Grand Championship. Then in 2016, the year so many had waited on, he won both the Columbia Spring Jubilee Grand Championship and the Christmas in July Grand Championship, setting the stage for one of the most memorable returns the Celebration has seen in modern years.

And when that moment came, he delivered in unforgettable fashion. On the final Saturday night of the 2016 Tennessee Walking Horse National Celebration, Honors entered the ring to a roar of applause and left it as the unanimous Five and Over Stallions Section B World Champion and ultimately the Tennessee Walking Horse World Grand Champion, with Larry Edwards in the irons for Keith and Dan McSwain. It was more than a win. It was the kind of moment that reminded people why they love this breed. It felt earned, long awaited, and bigger than one horse or one team. The crowd knew it, and so did everyone watching.

Honors retired with a perfect 20 and 0 show record. He never received a second place vote on a judge's card. That alone would have secured his place in history, but Honors was never going to be remembered only for what he did under the lights. His story was still unfolding.

As his show career was building, so was quiet interest in what he might become as a sire. During a break in his show schedule, Honors began his breeding career at Carl Edwards and Sons Stables. At the time, the barn was not yet the breeding operation it would later become, but demand for Honors changed that quickly. Once word got out that he would be available to breeders, people started calling from all over. The horse they had admired in the ring was now a horse they wanted represented in their own barns.

One of the things that helped set Honors apart in the breeding barn was the philosophy behind him. Even as his popularity soared, his connections remained committed to keeping him within reach of everyday horse people. That decision fit the identity he had already earned. Honors was not just a champion. He was a horse the public felt attached to. He was, in every sense, a horse people believed in.

Of course, the industry knows better than to assume every great show horse will become a great sire. Plenty do not. Honors did. In fact, he has done it on a level that puts him in very rare company.

To date, Honors has sired 1,388 registered horses, and his influence is showing up at the very highest levels of the sport. Leading that list is four time World Grand Champion Justified Honors, whose historic run in 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2025 made him the first horse in history to win four Tennessee Walking Horse World Grand Championships. Add 2024 World Grand Champion Cavender, and the Honors line continues to stamp its authority on the biggest stage in the industry.

To name just a few, his champion offspring include World Grand Champions Justified Honors, Cavender, The Honor Code, I Will Honor Thy Father, The Ultimate Honor, Kobe 24, My Honey Bee, Glory JC, Quite An Honor, Patrick Mahomes, Crypto, Gimme A Redneck Girl, The Chief BK, Hell or High Water, Ohtani, Sho Time, and Tide Pride; Reserve World Grand Champions General Thomas J. Jackson, Honored in Texas, and A Foolish Honor; World Champions All Time Honor, Honor and Remember, Tua THF, Acclaim, Honor My Country, The Jackalope, M.T. Pockets, Honor and Salute, The Holy Roller, A Dark Horse, Trophy Girl, God Bless Texas!, Twisted With Honors, Call My Lawyer, Silverback, and Chosen SF; and Reserve World Champions Lethal Ambition and Honor of the Ritz.

In 2025, Honors added another historic line to his résumé when he became the first horse in history to sire the Two Year Old World Grand Champion, the Three Year Old World Grand Champion, the Four Year Old World Grand Champion, and the Tennessee Walking Horse World Grand Champion all in the same year. Those winners were Sho Time, The Chief, Ohtani, and Justified Honors.

In the same breath, he also strengthened one of the most impressive streaks the breed has ever seen, becoming the sire of the last five Tennessee Walking Horse World Grand Champions, with Justified Honors winning in 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2025, and Cavender in 2024.

He has produced champion horses in performance, pleasure, and halter, proving that his influence reaches across divisions and continues to shape the breed at every level.

By the close of 2025, Honors' impact was further recognized with his induction into the Master Breeders' Hall of Fame. It was a fitting honor, not simply because of the number of foals he has sired, but because of the level at which they continue to win.

That is what makes Honors so rare. He had talent, but he also had consistency. He had presence, but he also had reliability. He had brilliance, but he also had the kind of natural gait and command that made people stop what they were doing and watch. Judging by what his offspring continue to do, he is passing those same qualities on.

Today, Honors stands not only as a former World Grand Champion, but also as a defining sire of this era, a horse whose name now carries just as much weight on a set of papers as it once did when it was called under the spotlight. He was undefeated in the show ring. He has become undeniable in the breeding barn. And with more than thirteen hundred registered offspring and a champion list that keeps growing, his influence on the Tennessee Walking Horse industry is already secure.

Some horses are remembered for what they did. Honors will be remembered for what he continues to do.

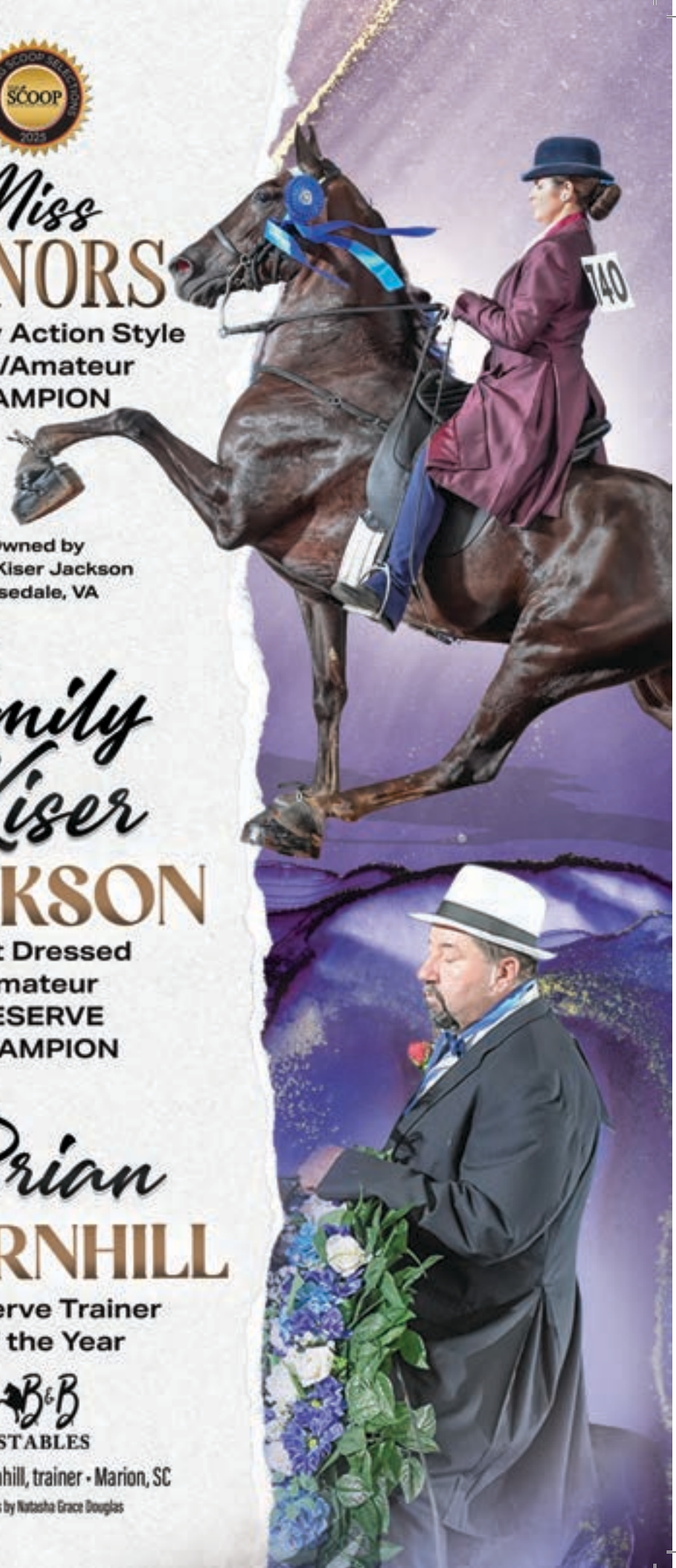

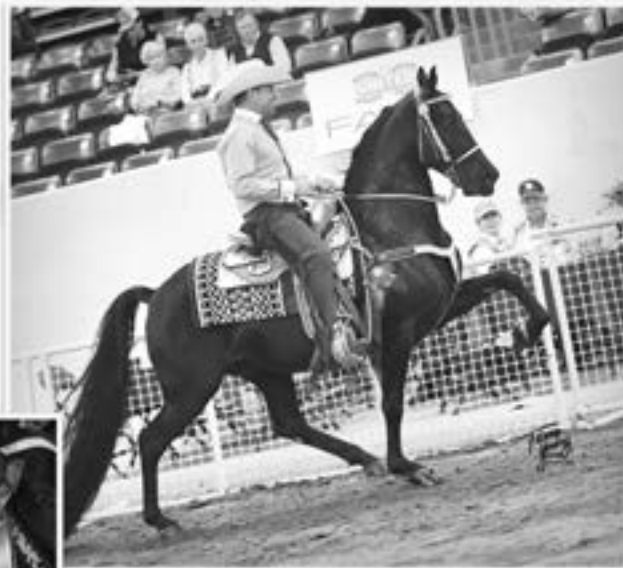

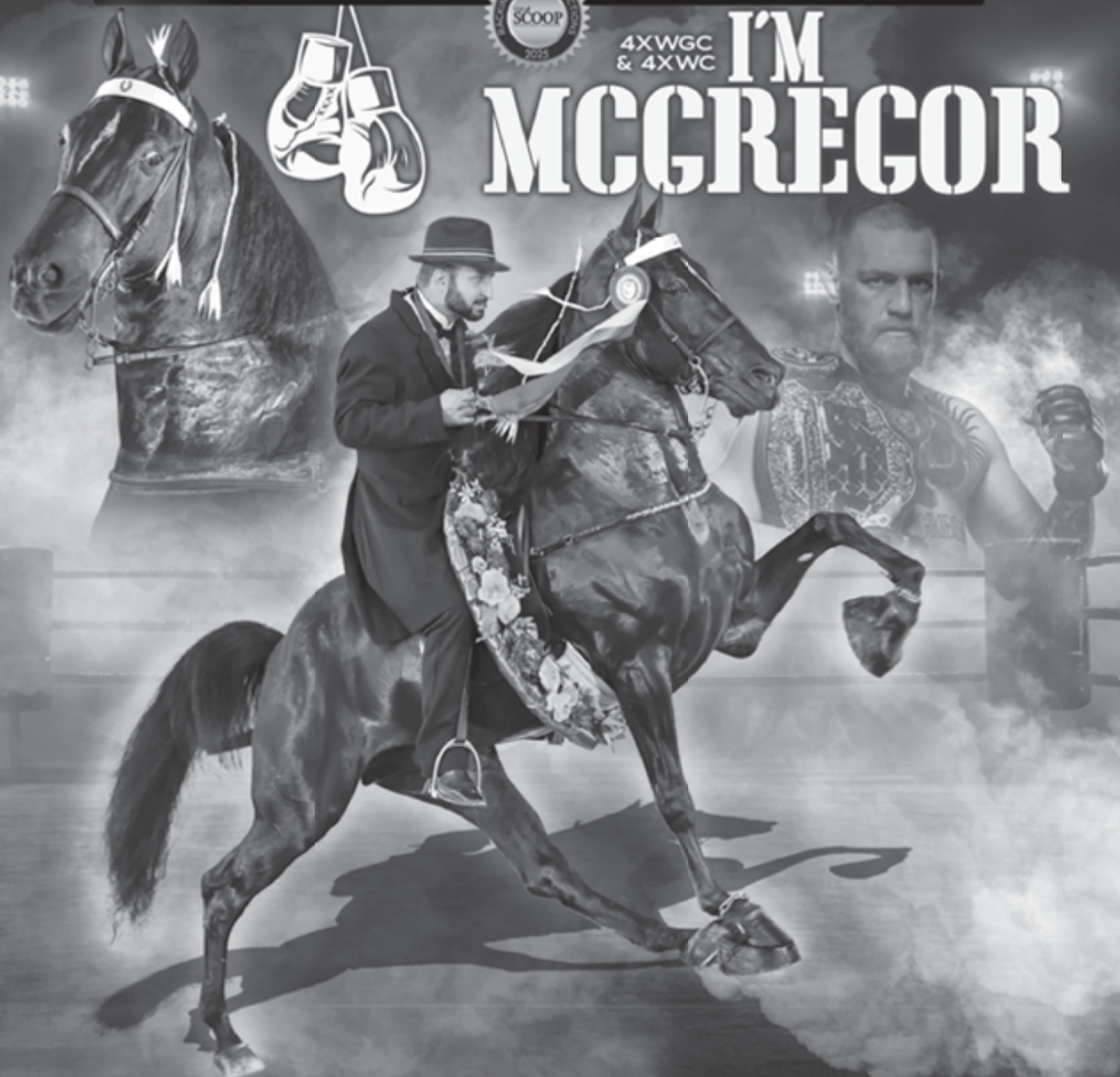

TWHBEA AWARDED TWO TENNESSEE AMERICA 250 GRANTS

TWHBEA is a recipient of a \$20,000 grant and a \$10,000 grant for Tennessee America 250 initiatives from the Tennessee Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial. The \$20,000 grant award will be used for a digitization project focused on preserving and expanding public access to its VOICE of the Tennessee Walking Horse magazine collection and historic photograph archive, which together document nearly 90 years of the breed's history and its impact on Tennessee communities. These materials capture the people, events, traditions, and evolving culture of the Tennessee Walking Horse, offering a rich visual and narrative record of the state's agricultural and social heritage.

The \$10,000 grant award will be used for the creation of a podcast series dedicated to preserving, interpreting, and sharing the living history of the Tennessee Walking Horse, drawing on the organization's 90 years of accumulated records, experiences, and expertise. The project will prioritize recording interviews with the few surviving foundational members of the industry whose firsthand knowledge represents an irreplaceable link to Tennessee's agricultural and cultural heritage. These voices, combined with archival research and expert commentary, will provide a rich, firsthand perspective on the breed's development and its role in Tennessee history.

This project is funded under an agreement with the State of Tennessee administered by the Tennessee Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial.
